

CERT: Community Emergency Response Team (6 classes)

California is a state where various large-scale natural disasters occur: Earthquakes, Fires, Floods, etc. Fremont Fire Department admits they do not have the resources and manpower to serve the entire community at once, so they developed the Community Emergency Response Team program to provide citizens the skills they need to assist themselves, their families, neighbors and fire department, if need be. Fremont Fire Department has been preparing and training Fremont citizens to respond to emergencies for the past fifteen years. Anyone interested in taking a CERT class must first attend a **Personal Emergency Preparedness (PEP)** class.

CERT Training = 7 FREE classes with detail, “hands-on” training in:

- Gas / Electric / Water Utility control
- Hazardous Material Recognition
- Building Damage Assessment
- Small Fire Fighting
- Search and Rescue
- First Aid / Triage
- Lifting heavy objects off trapped persons
- Lifting and moving injured people
- Incident Command System and Disaster Communications
